

Tri-Parish Pastoral Council Minutes – July 1, 2010 at 7 PM

Meeting opened with prayer by Father Kosse. New members Jim Buse, Lyle Siebenahler, Lori Bullerman and Julie Bauer were welcomed. Roll call was taken. The mass schedule was discussed, at length, for the three parishes. A letter about it that is to be sent to all the Tri-Parish parishioners was read and discussed. The council adjusted it to meet the satisfaction of those present. The letter explains why the mass schedule needs to be changed. With mass scheduling, the seating capacity of each church must be kept in mind. It is as follows: St. Joseph 140; St. Martin 240; St. Leo 660. Rotation of masses scheduling would not make a consistent mass schedule possible.

On Sept. 1, Faith formation starts at 11 A.M. This is the best time to start the new mass scheduling. As it stands now, mass will be at 4 PM at St. Martin's on Saturday, 8 AM on Sunday at St. Joseph and 10 AM on Sunday for St. Leo.

On August 5 at 7 PM we will all meet again to discuss the outcome of the letter being sent by Father Kosse.

Dennis B and Father Kosse will look into a recording system at Woodstock for the Radio Mass on Sundays.

Two classrooms have yet to be named. Names were submitted and notes were taken. The new classrooms are to be named Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Holy Spirit Room.

Miguel talked about a very large picture of Our Lady of Guadalupe from Mexico City that will be coming to St. Leo's Church. Because of its large size, dimensions are needed to see where it can be hung.
